#### **Electrology practical examination**

Ms. Wingate requested an ad hoc committee to discuss the electrology practical exam and bring back recommendations to the board. Mr. Holloway asked whether there were

SUBJECT: Periodic review of rules

At its August 2024 board meeting, the board will make final determinations about how to categorize its rules as part of a statutorily mandated review of rules. This memo provides background information to help you decide whether to approve the attached report. (I realize that the font attached report is very small and difficult to read. The board members' SharePoint site has the original Excel spreadsheet that will be much easier to read.)

#### What is the periodic review of rules?

Under G.S. 150B-21.3, agencies must conduct a decennial review of rules, in addition to an annual review. This decennial review (referred in this memo to the periodic review) consists of a determination by the agency whether each rules is necessary or unnecessary.

- If a rule is necessary, the agency will ultimately need to readopt the rule, which in many respects is much like proposing it as a new rule.
- If a rule is unnecessary, it will ultimately be removed from the code and be unenforceable.

#### What are the steps in the periodic review?

- 1. The agency receives and reviews for accuracy a report from the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) with all rules listed. (*Already completed.*)
- 2. The agency must decide which rules are necessary and which are unnecessary. (Already completed.)
- 3. The agency must publish the report and receive public comments. (*Already completed*.)

- 4. The agency must review the public comments and change its necessary/unnecessary determinations as necessary and according to statutory criteria. (*To be completed at the December 10 meeting.*)
- 5. The report must be submitted to OAH and the Rules Review Commission for approval.
- 6. The Commission submits the approved report to the General Assembly's Joint Legislative Administrative Procedures Oversight Committee (JLAPO).
- 7. If JLAPO meets within 60 days of the report submission, it will decide whether to recommend additional review by the agency or approve the report. If JLAPO doesn't meet within 60 days, the agency proceeds to the next step in the process.
- 8. Assuming JLAPO didn't require additional review, the agency readopts the rules determined to be necessary, and the unnecessary rules expire.

#### Where is the board in this process?

At this point, Steps 1-3 above have occurred.

#### Which rules are unnecessary, according to the ad hoc committee?

As a reminder, the board's ad hoc committee believed that most rules were necessary and should be readopted. However, there were a few rules that the committee believes are no longer necessary. Please note that there were also temporary rules that are listed as "unnecessary" here, but only because they're being adopted through a separate permanent rulemaking process and ultimately won't be relevant to this period-review process.

- 21 NCAC 06B .0309 (Records). The committee believes this rule is unnecessary because it simply repeats what appears in G.S. 150B-21.2(i), which requires agencies to keep records of rulemaking proceedings. The length these records must be kept is really in the purview of the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources. In addition, the rule only deals with the board's internal practices.
- 21 NCAC 06C .0101 (administrative hearings). The rule says, "Any person whose rights, duties, or privileges are affected by official actions of the Board shall be entitled to a hearing pursuant to G.S. 150B-38." This rule doesn't do anything more than what is required by G.S. 150B-38, so the committee believes it's unnecessary.
- 21 NCAC 06C .0502 (notice and hearing). This rule lists criteria for the chairman to consider when deciding the period between a notice and a hearing. The committee believes that the Rules Review Commission might object to this rule in the readoption process, and the rule doesn't appear to have any value. Typically, a hearing will occur at the next board meeting after a request is submitted, as long as the minimum time for notice is met, as set forth in statute.
- <u>21 NCAC 06C .0807 (allowance)</u>. This rule deals with petitions for intervention in hearings. We've never had intervenors at hearings, nor is the board's counsel

- aware of such petitions in board disciplinary hearings. Therefore, the committee recommends that the board designate the rule as unnecessary.
- 21 NCAC 06X .0111 (equipment endorsements and sales prohibited). This rule prohibits board-certified schools from endorsing, recommending, advertising, promoting, or selling "any type of laser, light-based device, epilator, or other electrolysis or laser hair removal equipment to the students or permit any other person to do so." There could be legal problems with the enforcement of this rule, but it's not uncommon for schools to provide equipment to students, and it's difficult to see the regulatory interest in preventing schools from doing so.

#### What action does the board need to take at its December meeting?

The board received no public comments on its initial determinations. I recommend that the board affirm its original determinations and file the report as attached.

SUBJECT: Permanent rulemaking

The board previously approved temporary rules for various electrology-related regulations. Most of these rules focused on electrology apprenticeship programs.

The enclosed rules would be permanent rules to replace the temporary rules. Overall, the language is the same. However, there were a few changes to reflect responses by or objections from the Rules Review Commission when the temporary rules were considered.

If the board still approves of the proposed rules, it should pass a motion to adopt them. I will then submit a proposed fiscal note for approval by the Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM). Following publication, there will be a 60-day public-comments period. Please note that the effective date in the rules may need to change, depending on when OSBM approves the fiscal note.

(b) No animals shall be permitted in an electrology facility except service animals as defined by 28 CFR 36.104, 24 25 which is hereby incorporated by reference, including subsequent amendments and editions, and is available for no 26 cost at https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-28/chapter-I/part-36/subpart-A/section-36.104. 27 (c) All bottles and containers that contain electrology equipment and supplies shall have labels that indicate the 28 contents. 29 (d) All electrology personnel and students shall wear the following during training and services: 30 (1) Scrubs or lab coats; 31 (2) Soft-soled shoes; 32 Surgical or N95 masks; and (3) 33 (4) Latex or nitrile gloves. 34 (e) The electrology facility shall comply with the infection-control rules in 21 NCAC 06V and post them in a conspicuous place.
